Information on Data Protection and Data Processing

This document provides important information, in a summarised form, on the protection of your personal data as regulated by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

1. Who is the data controller?

2. What personal data is processed and how is it collected?

We process the following personal data.

- Master and legitimation data/Personal master data (e.g., first name, last name, business address).
- Contact data (business contact information; e-mail address, telephone number etc.)
- Identification data/Behaviour data: e.g., IP address, browser details, the click history on the website of the service provider (GEP; see Item 8), location.
- Contract data.
- In addition, when registering natural person as described in Item 5 of this information sheet, we process the following personal data based on previously given consent: registered address, facial image, passport or any identity card data

Most of the personal data that we process about you has been provided by yourself; for example, when registering on the website, by visiting the home page, etc.

The exceptions are listed in Item 4 of this information sheet.

You have the right to access a detailed list of the data we hold about you.





3. For what purposes and on what legal bases will my personal data be processed?

Erste Group Procurement (EGP) is the central supply management organisation within Erste Group (EG), managing tender proceedings from the procurement perspective. EGP undertakes and is responsible for the execution of all supply management activities. In carrying out these activities, we make use of personal data. In detail, this means the following.

Processing due to a legitimate interest

There is a legitimate interest in the processing of data, by us or by third parties, in the following cases.

- To be able to conduct tender proceedings, to know with whom our employees can communicate in relation to a tender proceeding.
- Intragroup transfers of information with other members of the corporate Erste Group (e.g., for administrative purposes).
- To prevent unauthorised access, intrusion, misuse of the system and networks, personal data breaches, and cyber-attacks.
- To monitor access to systems.
- To detect and investigate security incidents.
- To investigate and report data breaches
- Exercising or defending rights
- Documentation of past damage cases as a decision-making aid for entering into new or extended business relationships
- Improving data quality
- Measures for process and quality management: We collect data on our processes and services on an event-driven basis. We use these data to ensure the quality of our services, compliance with our service standards and the efficiency of our processes.
- If you send us a file containing a digital signature or a digital seal, we will transmit this document to a validation service (e.g. signature verification service of "Rundfunk und Telekom Regulierungs-GmbH" the radio and telecommunications regulatory company) for signature/seal verification.
- If we provide a document that contains your data with our digital signature, we will transmit the document to a trust service provider (e.g. A-Trust).

Contractual necessity as a lawful basis for processing

In some cases, the completion of a tender proceeding results in contract signature. Each contract necessitates the processing of personal data. The data subject is a party to the contract or must take steps in order to enter into a contract. At the very least, this requires contact information. There are various types of procurement, and various types of contracts. The scope of data processing is defined in the contract documents.





Processing based on consent

If there is neither a contract nor a legal obligation or legitimate interest, data processing may still be lawfulif you have given us your consent to do so. The scope and content of such data processing always corresponds to the consent. You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.

However, a withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of any processing consented to and already undertaken. In other words, a withdrawal does not apply to past data processing activities.

4. Will data other than those collected from me be processed?

Most of the personal data we process about you was provided by you. However, your data may also originate from other sources:

5. Am I obliged to provide my personal data? What if I don't want to?

For our business relationship, we need some of your personal data. If we do not know your name and your e-mail address, for example, we will not invite you to participate in any EGP tender proceeding. With your e-mail address and name, we can contact you about day-to-day business and the tender itself. We will process your personal data only when necessary for the conducting of normal business procedures. If you do not want us to process your personal data, we may unfortunately not be able to do business with you,

If we are only allowed to process your data based on your consent, any such consent must be given by you on a purely voluntary basis. You are in no way obliged to provide your data in these cases.

In case you wish to participate as a natural person in the tender proceedings managed by EGP, to carry out know your supplier (KYS) procedure we will have to ask for your passport or any identity card data. The purpose of such processing is identification. If you do not consent, we may unfortunately be unable to enter a business relationship.

Separate consent shall be provided by the natural person that wish to be registered to be able to participate in the tender proceedings.





6. Is there decision-making based on automated processing - including profiling?

At the beginning of or during our business relationship, we do not use automated decision-making, in accordance with GDPR article 22.

7. To whom will my personal data be disclosed?

Your personal data may be disclosed to:

- Within bodies and persons of Erste Bank and Erste Group who require the data for contractual, legal or regulatory duties as well as for legitimate interests.
- Public bodies and institutions, if we are legally obliged to do so (e.g., financial authorities).
- Third parties commissioned by us; e.g., for IT and back office services, and bank auditors if they need such data to perform their work. Third parties are contractually obliged to treat your data as confidential, and to process them only within the scope of the services being provided.
- Third parties, if this is binding for performance of the contract or due to legal requirements.
- Validation services, e.g. Rundfunk und Telekom Regulierungs-GmbH (the radio and telecommunications regulation company), to the extent this is necessary to verify a digital signature or digital seal transmitted by you.
- Trust service providers, e.g. A-Trust, if we provide a document containing your data with our digital signature.

Disclosure to third parties may also take place if you have consented to the disclosure and for the period of your valid consent.

8. Are my personal data transferred to a third country?

Your personal data may be transferred to a third country in the following cases:

- this is necessary in order to assert, exercise or defend legal claims or there is a legal obligation
- Our processors may co-operate with sub-processors in third countries. (Currently this is not done.) Unless the transfer is based on an adequacy decision of the European Commission, we will transfer the data on the basis of appropriate or suitable safeguards.
- You will receive a special notification in other cases of data being transferred to a third country

EGP uses 'SMART by GEP', a SaaS (Software as a Service) arrangement, to carry out all procurement processes electronically. This SaaS is provided by NB Ventures, Inc. (doing business as GEP), 100 Walnut Avenue, Suite 304, Clark, NJ 07066, USA.





SMART by GEP is hosted in the Microsoft Azure Cloud Platforms in Microsoft's EU datacentres in Ireland and the Netherlands. Microsoft Azure datacentres are certified for control requirements for SSAE18, ISO27001, and ISO22301. The involvement of third parties during collection and processing of personal information undergoes due diligence to ensure compliance with the policy and regulatory requirements.

9. For how long are my personal data stored?

Your personal data are stored for at least as long as is necessary for the purposes for which they were collected. Records related to your persona which are handled by EGP are part of the "Supply management records" and "EGP contract records".

Where natural person is participating in tender proceeding conducted by EGP, data processed based on the consent given shall be retained for 3 (three) years starting from when that natural person last participated in the tender proceeding conducted by EGP. i.e. if you haven't participated or haven't been invited to any tender proceeding for 3 (three) years, personal data processed based on your consent shall be deleted.

NB Ventures, Inc. (doing business as GEP), as EGP's service provider and data processor (see Item 8), retains the collected data. When the contract concluded between EGP and GEP ends, all the data collected by GEP will be returned to EGP and deleted from GEP systems. (The initial contract term will expire in 2027.)

Apart from that, the period for which data must be stored is legally prescribed. These storage obligations may exist if you cease to be registered as a supplier.

10. What are my rights?

The GDPR grants you the following rights over your personal data.

- Access according to GDPR article 15.
- Rectification according to GDPR article 16.
- Erasure according to GDPR article 17.
- Restriction of processing according to GDPR article 18.
- Data portability according to GDPR article 20.
- Objection according to GDPR article 21.
- Decisions that are not exclusively based on automated processing, including profiling, according to GDPR article 22.





Whichever right you wish to assert, please submit your request, preferably in one of these two ways.

- By e-mail, ideally with your qualified electronic signature, sent to: mailto:Gdpr.egp@erstegroup.com

We ask you to understand that in cases of doubt, we will request more information about your identity. This also benefits your protection, to prevent unauthorised persons from accessing your data.

If you do not receive a timely answer to an application, or if in your opinion we have not handled your application legitimately, or if you think that your right to data protection has been violated, you may complain to the responsible supervisory authority:
